The first of its kind in the area, our camp offers both day camp and overnight camp with the coolest accommodations: state-of-the-art oTENTiks (think 'glamping' for kids)! Summer programs feature water-based activities and boating, archery, biking, and day trips, with a variety of programs for schools, families, and private groups in the spring and fall.

In this role you will:

- Lead and ensure the quality and safety of life-changing camp programs for children, youth, and groups, reflecting YMCA core values.
- Create a fun, enthusiastic, and camper-focused culture amongst the Camp Henry team.
- Manage facility operations, budgets, and schedules of YMCA Camp Henry, in coordination with Parks Canada following provincial regulations and standards.



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- Provide on-site leadership and risk-management for daily camp operations, including in the event of an emergency.
- Oversee camp administration and registration, engaging camp families with meaningful communications throughout the camp experience.
- Coordinate the recruitment, training, and supervision of the Camp Henry staff team.
- Ensure the safety of program facilities and equipment in line with legal, health, and risk-management standards and practices.
- Create strategic plans for the continued growth and development of Camp Henry programs.

You bring:

- 2+ years management and leadership experience in a camp or outdoor education environment.
- A meaningful connection to nature with a sense of adventure.
- A passion for supporting and motivating others through coaching and mentorship.
- Energy, flexibility, and a hands-on attitude in problem solving you thrive in a busy environment!
