



2025-2026 Volleyball Player Code of Conduct

General Guidelines for all players involved in the YMCA Volleyball League:

- Must have control over their emotions and actions at all times.
- Must sign a yearly code of conduct and assigned to a team roster to be eligible to play
- Treat opponents, YMCA staff and facility staff with fairness, courtesy and respect
- Verbal or physical abuse will not be tolerated
- When required, feedback should be provided in a constructive way
- All facilities must be treated with respect. This includes, but is not limited to, wearing appropriate footwear, not littering, not using unauthorized equipment, not entering a facility before the permit time begins, and leaving the facility by the end of the permit time.
- Players may only play with the team they are registered for

Zero Tolerance Policy

YMCA staff reserve the right to remove players from a facility or the league if they are involved with any of the following acts toward the Coordinator, facility staff, official, player, or spectator:

- Threatening and/or verbal abuse of an official, directly at another player or the League Coordinator.
- Intentionally pushing, shoving or making physical contact with another player, League Coordinator or official.
- Illegal players not assigned to a team roster
- Under the influence of alcohol or non-prescription drugs
